
Welcome to Hazel Class

Reading /communication

To read daily and regularly, questioning the story to consolidate understanding.

If you have an issue record it in the diary so children can tell the teacher to look in it or my door is always open! Alternatively ring up for an appointment.

If the child needs their book changing please don't wait for the next week inform the teacher and it can be changed on that day.

Library books will be issued on Friday and swapped over on Fridays. We only issue a new book when the old one has been returned.
